Want to start a local bluegrass radio station? This is the ticket!

The Local Community Radio Act, a bill to expand community radio nationwide, passed the U.S. Senate in December. The bill has already passed in the House of Representatives, and has been sent to President Obama for his signature.

In response to grassroots support during the past ten years, Congress has given the FCC a mandate to license thousands of new community stations nationwide. Specifically, the Local Community Radio Act will expand the low power FM service created by the FCC in 2000, a service the FCC created to add diversity of voices on the radio. At present over 800 LPFM stations, all locally owned, are on the air and run by non-profit organizations, local governments, churches, schools and emergency responders.

Federal Communications Commission Chairman Julius Genachowski said he would act quickly to put the measure into action, saying, "The FCC will

take swift action to open the dial to new low-power radio stations and the valuable local service they provide."

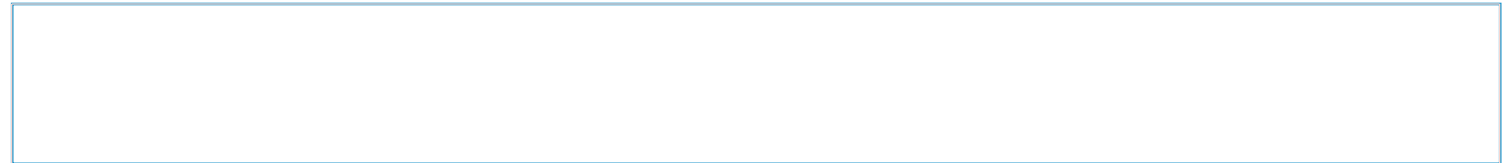
